He will come out and give you suggestion on how to reduce crime at your home. Some suggestions he recommended are: (1) See suspicious people or activity, get license plate number or vehicle details and call 911. (2) Record Serial numbers, take photos of items, engrave your driver license number on items that don't have a SN. Send that information to yourself via your email. (3) Audible alarms. (4) Lighting inside and out with timers or motion detector lights (5) Solid wood door with dead bolt lock. "Strike Master II Pro" could be added to strengthen to your existing door frame. (6)Secure road access with gate. (7) Prune shrub to 3 feet and trees up from ground 7 feet. (8) Tattoo or chip animals. (9) Do back ground check on hired help at WATCH Overview - Washington State Patrol (10) Talk to your neighbors, consider getting a block watch type app like "Next Door". (11) Large Dogs that will bark at intruders. (12) Be prepared to Run Hide or Fight. Watch with your family "Run Hide Fight" YouTube video. (13) Most important "Your stuff is replaceable but your life isn't!"
