KARELIAN BEAR DOG VISIT

One of the many great things about living in the Foothills is being able to enjoy a wide variety of wildlife right from our own homes. But we also know that sometimes wildlife gets a little too close for comfort. At the FRA 2019 Annual Meeting in January Foothills residents were treated to a unique opportunity to meet Jax, a highlytrained Karelian Bear Dog (KBD) and his handler Officer Keith Kirsch of the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife Police. The KBD program was established to provide a non-lethal method of moving potentially dangerous wildlife away from human-inhabited areas into which they may have ventured. This beautiful dog breed originates from Finland and Russia, and the animals are specially trained (at significant expense) to chase bears away, leaving them unharmed but "highly discouraged" from returning. With cats such as cougars, the KBDs are able to divert them into trees where agents can then tranquilize and relocate the wildlife safely. We really appreciated Officer Kirsch's informative presentation and the special opportunity to visit and play with Jax, an incredibly gentle, calm, and very talented Karelian Bear Dog!



The scholarship will be applied toward tuition and is paid directly to the recipient's college, university, or other accredited educational institution. Scholarships will be awarded to Foothills residents as determined by the Foothills Rural Association Scholarship Committee.

Consideration will be given to:

- Need and use of the scholarship (as explained in the essay)
- Academic achievements including Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Activities: can include school, community service, FRA participation, work experience, etc.
- Foothills residency (based on home address)
- Completion of the application materials and process as instructed

- Return all application materials to the Committee chairperson by WEDNESDAY MAY 15th.
- Applicants are required to be interviewed in person on the evening of WEDNESDAY MAY 22nd.



The Foothills Rural Association, 11000 N. Forker Road, was established as a non-profit corporation under section 502(c)4 of the Internal Revenue Code on December 12, 1983. The purposes of the corporation are to organize the property owners and/or current residents within the boundaries of Fire District 9 Station 6 to provide a forum by which the property owners and/or current residents can assist governmental agencies in better planning the use and resources of the Foothills area; and to preserve and protect the rural agricultural environment.

Voting Membership in the Association is open to any property owner or current resident within the Foothills boundaries. Membership dues are \$20 per year. Non-voting Membership is available to others through payment of dues. The Association is governed by elected volunteer officers and a board of directors.

The Foothills Community Center, 11000 N. Forker Road, which is located adjacent to the Foothills Fire Station, exists as a result of community efforts to save and renovate the former Foothills School Building. It is available for use by members of the Foothills Rural Association for a nominal utilities charge and by non-members for a reasonable rental fee. 
